# GSB

---

- Enrollment

- MBA = 803 fulltime students
- MS = 67 fulltime students
- PhD = 108 fulltime students



# MBA Program

---

- COA = \$87,081 (\$55,200 tuition)
  - 75% - 80% apply for Financial Aid
  - 55% - 60% receive Fellowship
- Fellowships awarded based on demonstrated financial need
- Loans available for both domestic and international students



# MS in Management

---

- Program is geared for middle management who are sponsored by their employer
- 10 month program
- Tuition = \$108,000
- Non sponsored only receive loans



# PhD Program

---

Receive full fellowship that covers tuition, health insurance and provides a living allowance stipend
